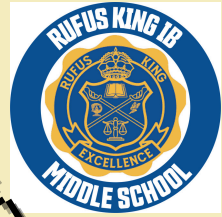

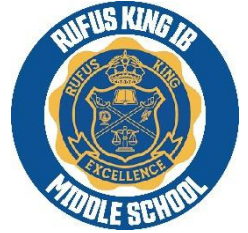

3) ~~Children Must Be Present~~

- A child must attend in order to receive a coat.

Registration is required.

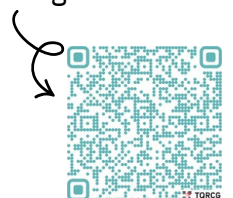

Where's the Bus?

An app for families



MPS families have access to an exciting app to help track their child's bus—**WheresTheBus**! Families can track their child's bus in real time.

WheresTheBus lets families know when their child's bus will reach the bus stop. The app tracks the bus location through GPS and provides up-to-the-minute arrival times.

The app is free! Families can access **WheresTheBus** from any device with internet capability—smartphone, tablet, PC, or iPad. Apple iOS and Android apps are available.



To access **WheresTheBus**, families must have a Campus Parent (parent portal) account with a login and password. These can be set up two ways:

1 At each child's school during regular school hours; an ID is required; OR

2 At MPS Central

Services, 5225 W. Vliet St., Milwaukee, WI, 53208, Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.; an ID is required

Get started with **WheresTheBus** today!

- 1 Log in to Campus Parent.
- 2 Search for **WheresTheBus** and click on the icon.
- 3 Follow the registration steps and instructions.
- 4 Download the app from the App Store (iOS/Apple) or Google Play (Android).
- 5 Log in with your Campus Parent ID and password to open the app and see bus information.

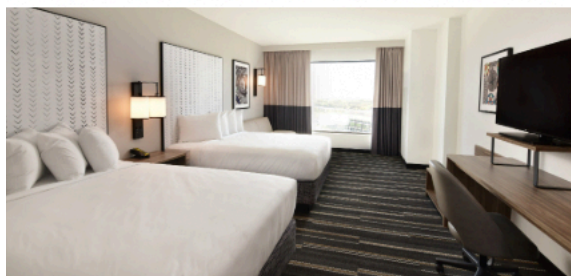
