



## MPS Afterschool Activity Buses!

MPS is providing Afterschool Activity Buses for students at select schools to transport them home from their afterschool activities.



### Ready to sign up?

If you have a child who participates in an afterschool activity (Athletics, Clubs, CLCs, Safe Places, Camps, etc.) and you would like them to take the activity bus home, please complete the After-school Activity Bus permission form by visiting [bit.ly/mpsafterschoolbusing](https://bit.ly/mpsafterschoolbusing) or use your smartphone's camera to scan the QR code to the right.

***You must complete a permission form for each child you approve to ride the Afterschool Activity Bus.***

### Please Note:

- There is **no cost** for this transportation service.
- Buses will be available up to **five days a week**.
- Signing up for this transportation service **will not change** any existing school bus transportation your child may already be receiving.
- You and your child may **opt out of this transportation service at any time**. Please inform the school of any changes.
- Students are expected to **follow the Transportation Safety Student Code of Conduct**. See the [MPS Rights and Responsibilities Handbook](#) for full details.

### Helpful Information:

**You will be able to select the address** where you would like your child to be dropped off. Every effort will be made to drop your child off at the address listed, but we may have to use a nearby corner. The address does not need to be your home address, but only one address will be kept on file for each student utilizing the MPS Afterschool Activity Bus.

**If your child is 11 years old or younger**, they will need to be met by an adult or accompanied by an older sibling when getting dropped off by the bus. Children who are not met by an adult or accompanied by an older sibling when dropped off will be brought back to their school and parents/guardians will need to pick their child up from school. If this becomes a frequent occurrence, transportation services will be discontinued.
